(a harmony of the gospels from John 6:14-21 and Mark 6:45-52)

John 6:14 After the people saw the miraculous sign that Jesus did, they began to say, "Surely this is the Prophet Who is to come into the world."

Mark 6:45 Immediately Jesus made His disciples get into the boat...while He dismissed the crowd

John 6:15, 17 [the disciples] set off across the lake for Capernaum. By now it was dark, and Jesus had not yet joined them. Jesus, knowing that they intended to come and make Him king by force, withdrew again to a mountain by Himself.

Mark 6:47 When evening came, the boat was in the middle of the lake, and He was alone on land.

John 6:18 A strong wind was blowing and the waters grew rough.

Mark 6:48 He saw the disciples straining at the oars, because the wind was against them. About the fourth watch of the night He went out to them, walking on the lake.

John 6:19-21 When they had rowed three or three and a half miles, they saw Jesus approaching the boat, walking on the water; and they were terrified. But he said to them, "It is I; don't be afraid."

Mark 6:51 Then He climbed into the boat with them, and the wind died down. They were completely amazed.

John 6:21 and immediately the boat reached the shore where they were heading.
