

### How Moses Realized Privilege

1. \_\_\_\_\_ - He was raised in Pharaoh's household.
2. \_\_\_\_\_ - He was schooled in Egypt. (Acts 7:22)
3. \_\_\_\_\_ - He was a great leader and general.
4. \_\_\_\_\_ - He was heir to the throne of Egypt.

**How Moses Responded in Weakness** – Throughout his life Moses struggled with \_\_\_\_\_ and taking matters into his own hands. (Exodus 2:11-15; 32:19; Psalm 106:32)

*Exodus 3:1-4*

1 Now Moses was tending the flock of Jethro his father-in-law, the priest of Midian, and he led the flock to the far side of the desert and came to Horeb, the mountain of God. 2 There the angel of the LORD appeared to him in flames of fire from within a bush. Moses saw that though the bush was on fire it did not burn up. 3 So Moses thought, "I will go over and see this strange sight— why the bush does not burn up." 4 When the LORD saw that he had gone over to look, God called to him from within the bush, "Moses! Moses!" And Moses said, "Here I am."

Like Moses all of us have this incredible capacity to resist God's grace. We shy away from it, unable to believe that it is actually true. By doing so, we not only resist grace, but we end up resisting God Himself.

### How Moses Resisted Grace

*Exodus 4:10, 13*

**GRACE says, "I am willing to accept you as you are; will you accept yourself as you are?"**

3. He resisted grace by allowing his \_\_\_\_\_ to control him rather than the \_\_\_\_\_ of God.

*Exodus 3:13*

*Moses said to God, "Suppose I go to the Israelites and say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you,' and they ask me, 'What is his name?' Then what shall I tell them?"*

*Moses answered, "What if they do not believe me or listen to me say, 'The LORD did not appear to you'?"*
